# **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The Corners Café is not just another restaurant and working at the café is not just a job! Corners Café was designed by youth and is for youth. We are a youth-run restaurant and we serve youth and adults from all over Alameda County and the Bay Area. We also help each participant get college credit, learn about business, and help them find permanent employment.

#### HOW IT WORKS- 5-Steps to Success

#### STEP 1- APPLY AND INTERVIEW

- Please read through this package, complete the application and return ALL forms to CORNERS CAFÉ: 8711 MacArthur Blvd, Oakland, CA
- You will be called within one week and invited to an informational meeting and interview (times to be announced)
- We will accept 25 new participants- they will be notified soon

#### STEP 2- YOUR IN- NOW WHAT DO YOU DO?

- Attend a meeting about Laney College's Culinary Course (date to be announced)
- Attend pre-selected culinary course
- Earn credits from Laney College for passing the course
- Maintain AT LEAST a C average to continue on with the Corners Café Training Program
- Do not miss more than 3 Culinary classes

# STEP 3- YOU HAVE SOME SKILLS IN THE KITCHEN- WHAT'S NEXT?

- Attend a business course 2x a week for 8-10 weeks hosted by Global Education Partnership
- Learn about cost of goods sold, cash handling, inventory control and hospitality business practices
- Do not miss more than 5 business classes

#### STEP 4- YOU KNOW HOW TO ROLL DOUGH AND COUNT DOUGH- NOW MAKE SOME DOUGH

- If you have completed both the culinary and business course and you are in good standing you can clock in and start making an hourly wage by either working at the café or for our catering co.
- You have up to 12 months to work for us and get on- the- job training
- Learn what it is like in a fast-paced kitchen environment
- Cook, clean, and be a cashier

# STEP 5- WE LOVE YOU, BUT YOU CAN'T WORK AT CORNERS FOREVER

- Build your resume skills and write your resume with our staff
- Learn how to act, what to wear and what questions to ask in an interview
- Meet restaurant and hotel managers from all over the Bay Area
- Be hired by great restaurants, bars and hotels on a full-time basis!
